

Why doesn't the Housing Authority accept applications for every program all of the time?

Hempstead Housing Authority (HHA) only has limited funding available from HUD. The funding is budgeted annually in order to assist the most families possible. The waiting list remains closed if there are enough families subsidized and enough families on the list to meet foreseeable funding availability.

Hempstead Housing Authority does not keep a list of interested applicants that want an application when the list opens. Notification about when any lists are open is done by advertisement in the local media, the HHA voice message system, notices distributed to local community centers, Village of Hempstead Library, community organizations, and other means as deemed practical by HHA.
